- Architecture** In the late 1930s, the building that is now The View was home to Kewanee Boiler. Today the special events space contains three fantastic levels: downstairs it is all about high ceilings and open space, mid level hosts a boardroom with modern furnishings and video conferencing abilities while the upstairs lounge is perfected by its glass outer wall and adjacent balcony featuring Atlanta's most spectacular view.
- Design** Not a nightclub, The View at King Plow is available solely for special events and features a design likened to a blank palette. For the client, the simple décor means individualizing and creating just the right atmosphere for any event is that much easier. However, even with the simple design, the space remains modern and stylish with painted cement floors, filmy drapery and numerous plasma televisions.
